

## 49er LEAGUE RULES

The Angels Gun Club 49er Trap League is a family league and all conduct should take that into consideration. Please show courtesy at all times to all shooters and non-shooters. Please dispose of all waste in garbage cans.

### SAFETY FIRST

Keep your gun unloaded and the action open at all times unless in position to shoot. Load only one shell at a time. **PARTICIPANTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO CONSUME ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BEFORE OR DURING SHOOTING.**  
**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE PARKING LOT, TRAP BUILDING, OR ON THE RANGES.**

### TEAMS

*Teams must consist of at least one AGC Member, five members total. All money paid must be received from the club member ONLY.* Every team must have a minimum of three team members present to shoot for a team score that night. Teams are not to adjust the traps themselves. Please contact the Trap Master for adjustments. Every effort will be made to throw legal targets.

### SUBSTITUTES

Substitutes may not be a member of any other team. They may shoot for only one team per week, but may substitute for more than one team during the league. They will be eligible for Perfect Fifty awards only. If no substitutes are available, teams will be scored using the following formula: the average of members present minus 10 targets for each team member missing.

### START TIME AND SCORE KEEPING

The first team scheduled to shoot will begin at 6:00pm. Teams will start on time and every team will have one half hour (30 minutes) to complete their singles and handicap rounds. Teams will provide a score keeper and puller for the team following them. Teams should decide who will pull and score before they shoot and they should promptly put their guns away and return to score and pull for the following team.

### SHOOTING AND THE HANDICAP

The first round will be 16 yard singles. The highest score in the first round will determine the handicap distance. The minimum distance will be 19 yards. All squads that have a handicap of 20 yards or less will have shooters separated by no more than one yard. Squads shooting from the 21-25 yard lines will have no more than two yards separation. This is for your safety.

### AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to the members of the League Champion team, the winning team in each division, the runner-up in Division I, the champion and runner-up in each class, the highest and runner-up Lady, and the highest and runner-up Junior. All ties will be decided at a shoot
